## RAD ASSESSMENT TERMS & CONDITIONS (2026)



Before registering for an RAD Assessment, please read the following important information. These details ensure you understand the commitments, requirements, and conditions involved in preparing for and participating in an assessment.

### 1. Assessment Dates & Scheduling

- 1.1. Assessments will be held between June 29 and July 5, 2026.
- 1.2. Exact dates and times for each group will be confirmed once all South Australian entries are scheduled by the RAD.
- 1.3. The RAD sets the timetable, and specific time requests cannot be accommodated, even if your declared unavailability was submitted at the time of registration.
- 1.4. The RAD reserves the right to adjust schedules; you will be notified as soon as possible if this occurs.

### 2. Rehearsals & Attendance Requirements

- 2.1. All levels (except *Dance to Your Own Tune*) require at least one dress rehearsal, held on a Friday evening or weekend depending on student availability.
- 2.2. Some levels require additional classes, scheduled on an evening or weekend.
- 2.3. Students entered for an *Examination* must attend:
  - 2.3.1. Sunday classes during Term 2, and
  - 2.3.2. Two classes during the April school holidays (April 20–26, 2026).
- 2.4. All students must maintain regular class attendance throughout Terms 1 and 2. Excessive absences may result in withdrawal from the assessment.
- 2.5. Simply Ballet reserves the right to refuse an entry or withdraw a student if it is deemed the student is not ready, or unsafe to participate.

### 3. Availability During Assessment Week

- 3.1. When registering, you must list any dates the student is unavailable during the assessment period (e.g., travel, medical procedures).
- 3.2. Unavailability must be declared at the time of registration; late notice dates cannot be accommodated.
- 3.3. Unavailable dates are not guaranteed to be accommodated by the RAD.

### 4. Costs & Inclusions

- 4.1. A breakdown of costs will be provided on your invoice. Total assessment costs include:
  - RAD entry fee
  - Music fees
  - Character skirt hire
  - Discovering Repertoire/Higher Grades skirt hire
  - Prop hire
  - Staff attendance on the day
  - Dress rehearsals
  - Photography (if applicable)
  - For *Examination* Students only: Extra school holiday classes

Costs do NOT include:

- Regular uniform items (leotards, tights, shoes etc.)
- Private lessons
- Any extra Sunday classes in term 2
- RAD Workshops

### 5. Refunds & Withdrawals

5.1.1. Fees paid to the RAD are only refundable under specific conditions outlined in the [RAD Refund Policy](#).

5.1.2. Fees paid to Simply Ballet may be refundable depending on your circumstances.

5.1.3. **No change of mind refunds** or refunds for revised *unavailable dates* can be offered once entries have been submitted to the RAD.

5.1.4. If a student becomes unwell or injured close to the assessment:

- The [RAD's policies](#) will apply.
- A medical certificate may be required for any refund consideration.

### 6. Communication

6.1.1. All assessment information will be communicated via email.

6.1.2. You are responsible for checking email regularly and ensuring contact details are up to date.

### 7. Registration & Payment

7.1.1. Registration forms and payments are due **no later than May 1, 2026**.

7.1.2. Once your registration form is received, an invoice will be issued for your assessment costs.

7.1.3. Invoices must be paid in full **by 6pm on May 1** for your entry to be submitted.

7.1.4. **No late entries or late payments can be accepted under any circumstances.**
